

Rules & Regulations

- Unfair practice of idea presentation will be straightly disqualified.
- Any decision on winner, qualification of idea and grounds on which idea is awarded, strictly binds to the final ruling only by the judge panel.
- Any idea must contain the initial business model to be either presented or explained in means such that your idea does't get unattended.
- During registrations, one must specify a leader, if any in a team, for any future communication purposes from Repertus. Charges specified in website for registrations are mentioned in context to per head per idea, for this event.
- In team registrations, leader must specify the names and contact details of the team members. No changes will be allowed after successful payment and completion of registrations. So fill up carefully.
- During registrations, one must write an abstract describing their idea of startup in 300-400 words, after which you'll be directed to payment portal, to successfully register for the event.
- Participants must bear their college identity cards in campus premises. Fraudulent names/identity card holders will not be allowed to present their ideas.
- No change in the team structure is permitted after the team is registered. Please register your team after careful thought and deliberation.

- No participating team may under any circumstances attempt to contact a judge before announcement of winners. Any such behavior will result in the disqualification of the team from the competition.
 - The participants are not allowed to ask for any information regarding other teams and their members. Failing to abide by shall risk the team to disqualification.
 - Teams shall bring backups of their business plan while attending the competition. In case, if an idea fails to present due to unavailability of the data like corrupt flash drive or virus deletion, no such excuse will be tolerated and team shall be not be allowed a second chance to present.
 - The participants shall should not be indulged in any other events during IdExpo.
 - Any inter-participant disputes caused under any circumstances will be subjected to severe actions decided by the institute.
 - Any loss caused by the participants to the institute property would result in strict action.
 - There are no refunds in any case possible.
 - All transaction made offline—for registration, a proof i.e. receipt must be presented before enrolling at the event in campus.
 - All communications regarding submissions of idea abstract, contact details, etc. shall be made only through IdExpo portal of Repertus website.
 - Your **pitch presentation must include business propaganda, kind of change the market experiences—by your idea, and business model descriptions**, in any form, in support to the idea you wish to present, such that it is startup ready.
 - Signing on a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) before commencement of ‘IdExpo’ is mandatory. Failing to do so, one shall not be allowed to present their idea.
